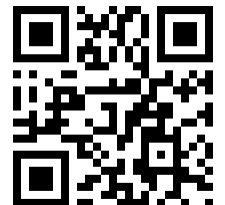

Quizlet is now **optional!** Set Champions will still earn stickers. If you get below a C on a Vocab Quiz, Quizlet can be completed for credit.

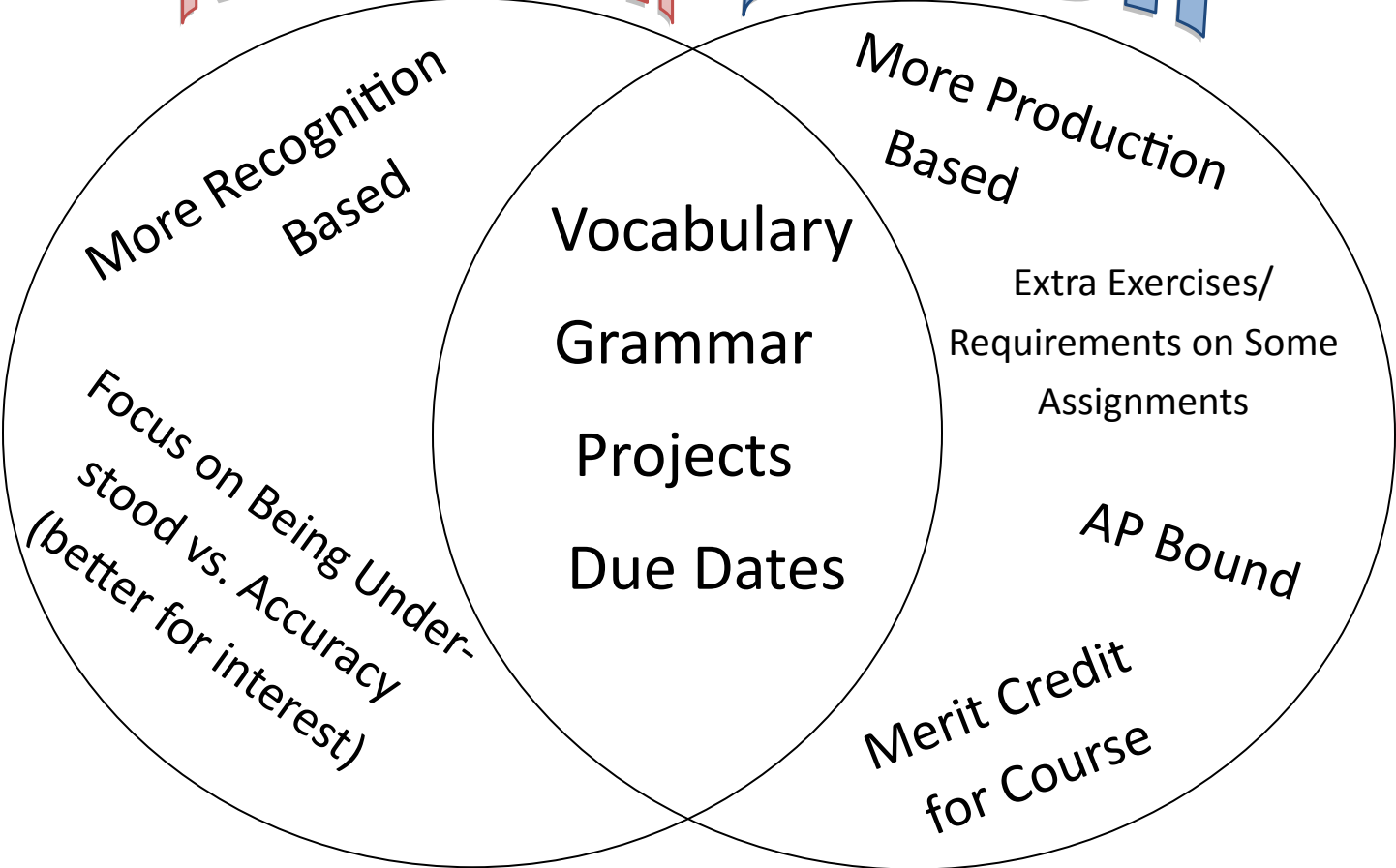
