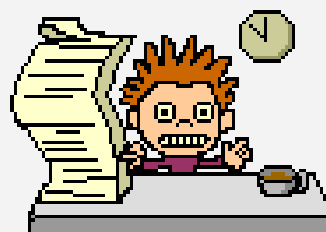

Classwork will be graded on accuracy **and** completion, but it can be re-submitted at any time for full credit.

Assessments: This includes projects, essays, tests and quizzes. There may be writing, listening, speaking and/or reading exercises on quizzes and tests. Oh, and there will be both **announced AND unannounced** quizzes! Don't worry, most will be announced with at least a week prior notice.

2. AP-Übungen: Exercises similar to those on the AP exam will be given in class. They are graded on accuracy. There will be at most one a week (this may change closer to the AP test). See the schedule for details.

Quizlet is now **optional!** Set Champions will still earn stickers. If you get below a C on a Vocab Quiz, Quizlet can be completed for credit.



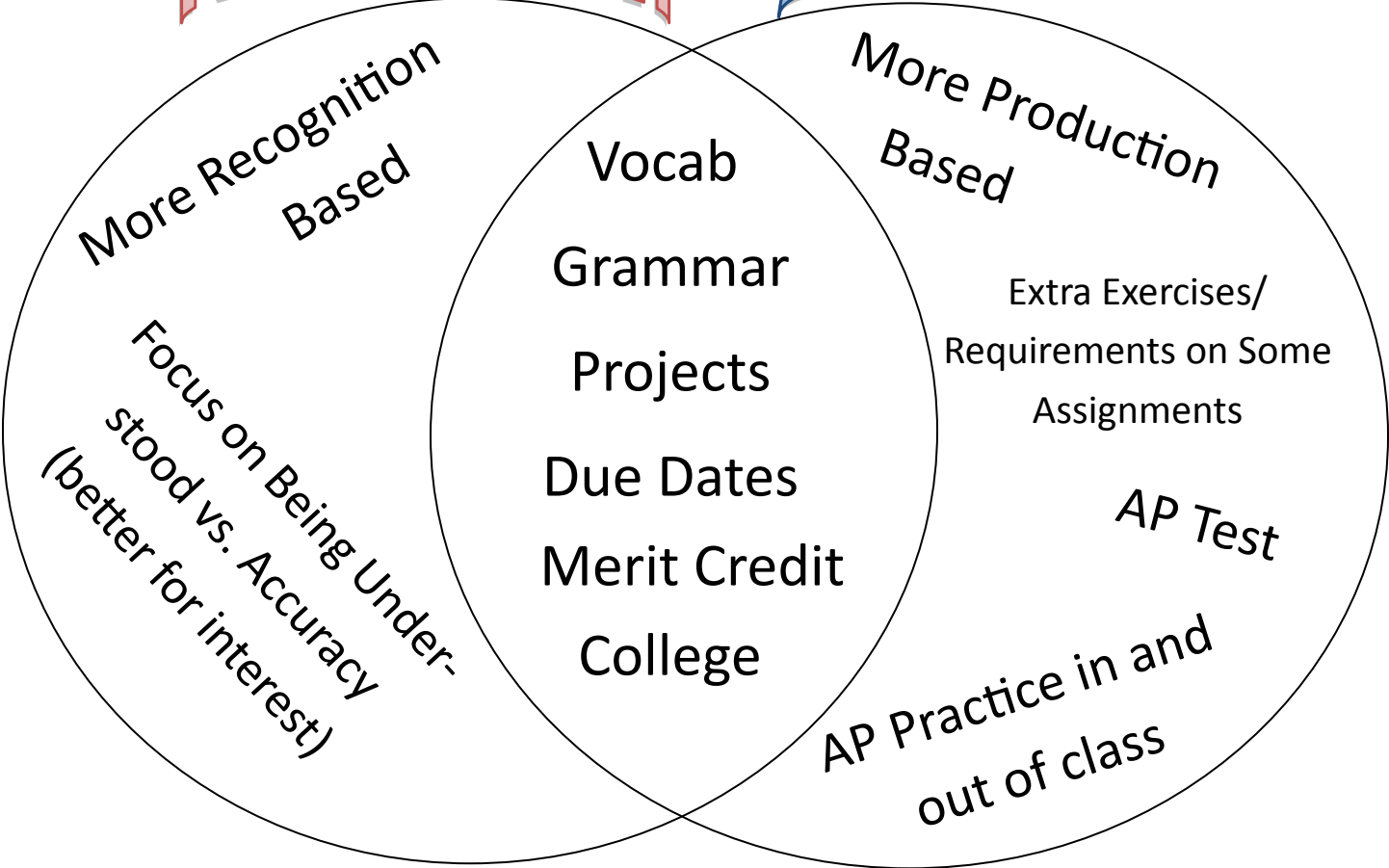
